Paul O'Connell faces late fitness worries for Ireland clash Fitness concerns are mounting for Munster captain Paul O'Connell after his omission from the Guinness Pro12 team to face Wales. The IRFU have ruled the 34-year-old out of Saturday's autumn international in Cardiff. And he is unlikely to feature in Munster's Heineken Cup trip to Leinster on October 16, with Coach Declan Kidney saying his absence is precautionary. "I'm just not sure if he'll be fit for the next round yet," said Kidney. "I need to look at that situation. He hasn't trained." But O'Connell added: "I'm not too worried about it. "I don't know when I'll be back. I do think about it, but I don't think it's the great problem it looks like." O'Connell, who has played every game this season, was ruled out of Ireland's World Cup plans in the summer because of a stress fracture to his ankle. He has also missed three Munster games with groin injuries. Fitness is key for Ireland and the O'Connell situation is an unwelcome distraction as players start preparing for their biggest challenge of the season. However, the IRFU are monitoring the situation and are confident of a swift resolution. A GAA statement read: "The withdrawal is due to injury and the patient will be re-assessed in due course." Kidney was in cautious mode as he prepared his Munster for the French visitors, while the Australian John Hayes was also ruled out of the tie. Hayes has been in camp since returning from a calf injury and Kidney said he was "completely refreshed" but lacks match fitness after being involved in two training sessions at home.
